

**SATURN PROJECT AUCTION - At the National Waterways Museum, Ellesmere Port

LOT 1

Handbowl, galvanised, 12 inches diameter at top, green painted background with traditional decoration by Ron Hough of Braunston. Protective varnish has slightly darkened with age, otherwise in very good condition. Good example of Hough castle painting on base in excellent condition.



LOT 2

Dipper/grain scoop, galvanised with wooden handle, 9 inches diameter, green painted background with traditional decoration by Ron Hough of Braunston, insc. TREMORDEN. Paintwork badly chipped and shabby from wear in places but still an attractive item.



LOT 3

Watercan, galvanised, one gallon capacity, green painted background with traditional decoration by Ron Hough of Braunston, insc. TREMORDEN on red centre band. Although the paintwork is chipped in places this is a strong can in good condition.



LOT 4

Framed print, Saturn on Pontcysyllte Aqueduct, from an original painting by Dusty Miller. Saturn is depicted as crossing the aqueduct as working on the Llangollen Fly-boat service c.1910.



LOT 5

Watercan, galvanised with turned wooden carrying handle, three gallon capacity, black painted background with traditional decoration understood by donor to be by Roy Waring of Leigh, insc. ALCOR on centre band. There is some crazing to the varnish and minor chips to paintwork on the top only, otherwise this is a very decorative can in near perfect condition.



LOT 6

Watercan, galvanised, three gallon capacity, green painted background with traditional decoration by Ron Hough of Braunston. A few minor chips in paintwork have been carefully re-touched, otherwise this is a strong can in near perfect condition
